

Roosevelt University Auditorium Building

Directions to Chicago College of Performing Arts

CCPA's facilities are located on various floors in Roosevelt University's Auditorium Building. Please refer to the directions below to access the room(s) for your event.

The Auditorium Building may be accessed by either of the following entrances:

Michigan Avenue entrance: 430 S. Michigan Avenue (closes at 6pm on weekends)

Wabash Avenue entrance: 425 S. Wabash Avenue

1st floor

Wabash entrance: pass through turnstiles on the right side of the lobby, arrive at Gage Gallery

Michigan entrance: not accessible; please use Wabash entrance

6th floor

Wabash entrance: pass through turnstiles on the right side of the lobby, take elevators to 6th floor

Michigan entrance: take elevators to 6th floor

7th floor

Wabash entrance: pass through turnstiles on the right side of the lobby, take elevators to 7th floor

Michigan entrance: take elevators to 7th floor

9th floor

Wabash entrance: pass through turnstiles on the right side of the lobby, take elevators to **8th floor**, walk down the hallway (toward lower 800s) to the center stairway, take stairs to the 9th floor (or continue all the way down the hallway to the Michigan elevators, take elevators to 9th floor)

Michigan entrance: take elevators to 9th floor

10th floor

Wabash entrance: pass through turnstiles on the right side of the lobby, take elevators to 10th floor

Michigan entrance: take elevators to **8th floor**, walk all the way down the hallway (toward upper 800s) past the center stairway and tower elevator to the Wabash main stairway and elevators, take stairs or elevators to the 10th floor

14th floor

Wabash entrance: pass through turnstiles on the right side of the lobby, take elevators to **8th floor**, walk down the hallway (toward lower 800s) to the tower elevator, take the tower elevator to the 14th floor

Michigan entrance: take elevators to **8th floor**, walk down the hallway (toward upper 800s) to the tower elevator, take the tower elevator to the 14th floor

Accessibility Information

Most CCPA spaces are handicap accessible (*exception: Mikowsky Hall contains steps to enter audience seating and performance area*). Additional accommodations are offered in Ganz Hall to meet the needs of all visitors (information below).

Ganz Hall (AUD 745)

Ganz Hall may be accessed by elevator from both the Wabash Avenue and Michigan Avenue entrances. A ramp leads to the entrance of Ganz Hall. Three steps lead to the stage from backstage. Performers may request a ramp be installed over top of the stairs.

Ganz Hall's aisles are wide enough to accommodate wheelchair seating in all rows.

Assistive listening devices are available upon request.

Restrooms

Men's and women's restrooms are available on most floors of the Auditorium Building with the following exceptions:

1st floor: men's and women's restrooms available on the first floor of the Wabash building. To access, ask for assistance at the security desk in the lobby.

6th floor: women's restrooms only; the nearest men's restrooms are on the 7th floor.

10th floor: no restrooms available; the nearest men's and women's restrooms are on the 8th floor.

Tower (11–18th floors): men's and women's restrooms available on 16th floor.

Gender-neutral restrooms:

The Auditorium Building has two gender-neutral restrooms. Additional gender-neutral restrooms are available in the adjoined Wabash Building.

Wabash Building, 2nd floor: to access, ask for assistance at the security desk in the lobby.

Auditorium Building, 8th floor: near Wabash elevators/stairway, not handicap accessible

Auditorium Building 10th floor: only accessible using Michigan elevators/stairway; maintains limited hours. *If you anticipate needing the 10th floor gender-neutral, handicap accessible restroom for your event, please make arrangements with Scheduling and Facilities Office.*

Please make all accessibility requests at least one business day prior to your event. Contact CCPA's Scheduling and Facilities Office to make requests or address any other accessibility concerns.
